INTRODUCTION

Our Club was formed in 1969 to cater for those owners of purebred dogs who were interested in trailing their dogs to Obedience Trial standard and has been very successful in this regard. On being granted affiliation with the Victorian Canine Association in 1979, all breeds whether registered or not have been accepted.

CLUB RULES

- All dogs should be kept on leash at all times, excepted when given permission to work off leash in class.
- Handlers wishing to leave their dogs tied up on the Club grounds should only do so if their dogs are safe with people especially children. No dog may be tied up where it can reach another dog.
- Dogs in season should not come down to training for four weeks. This does not mean you should stop the training of your dog.
- Dogs must be immunised against distemper and canine hepatitis before coming to classes. This should also be renewed yearly.
- A dog suffering from any illness or skin problems should not be brought to classes until a Vet has pronounced the condition not contagious.
- Handler must remove their dogs excreta from the training area implements are provided.
- Physical punishment of dogs is not permitted in training classes.
- Instructors have authority over their classes and may ask a member to take their dog out of class if it is disruptive.
- Instructors are not permitted to handle and train a member's dog in class.
- While at the grounds before and after classes please control your dogs.

Training Tips

Always be consistent with your training, if your dog is not responding to your commands, then go back to basics and show your dog what you want of him 1 her.

Always walk off on your left foot when heeling the dog, if you have placed your dog on a sit stay do not forget to leave on your right foot.

Only give one command not three or four quick responses, show the dogs what you want of them, and encourage the dogs instead of pulling their heads off.

BAKED BIKKIES

Before you start, these are not always popular with dogs - however many love them.

Ingredients: Small packet of beef or chicken stock. Cubes have too much salt, which

is added to make up with water 1.5 litres. If you wish, add no name instant milk powder to the solution and mix skim milk for fatties.

2 kg wholemeal flour - you might prefer to make up the 2kg with a mix of flour - 1.5kg and substitute lecithin and wheatgerm to make up the mix to

2kg.

165g Oatmeal 55ml Vegetable oil

Method:

Mix the dried ingredients together. A plastic laundry bucket saves heaps of stress and mess. You can add granulated garlic and /or finely chopped parsley if you want. If you are making liver snaps that day finely chopped pieces of liver are quite happy to mince in your food processor. Remove any skin or sinews before pieces. If feeling generous to the dry mix and additives add the 1.5 litre of liquid and squish around until you have a still mix. Rubber or surgical gloves make commonsense - they are easier to clean than bare hands. Then, on a greased oven tray place your mix, appropriately presented for the size of your dog. Set oven at 150 celsius. Little dogs and puppies cope with a flat biscuit easier. Roll the Mix out to the desired thickness - do it in batches and cut with a scone or bikkie cutter. Bigger dogs benefit from a sausage shape think saveloy or frankfurt. There is no time to ensure that these biscuits come out of the oven hard and dry. So just keep an eye on them after the first hour. They are the dream of a lousy cook hard and dry!!! Great for teeth and gums - with no artificial additives or food dyes

To all Dog Owners

Please don't forget to carry something to pick up the poo when, walking your: dog. This is required by law. You are responsible for what your dog leaves behind and you and finds can be hefty if you are caught not cleaning up the mess.

Vaccinations

Are your "Pets" shots up to date? The risk of disease is ever present. Vaccination is their only protection. If they have lapsed for whatever reason, your "Pet" may no longer be protected. Their immune system slowly looses its immunity if regular exposure doesn't happen. A vaccination is a measured exposure to help maintain immunity without getting the disease. If you are going away next school holidays with your "Pet" or boarding them out, make sure they are protected. A phone call is all it takes to your vet.

Do The Right Thing

Out of consideration for other park users, all dog owners should ensure they carry a plastic bag or some such container with which they can collect their droppings and dispose of in the bins provided, or carry home and dispose of in the way they keep their own back yard clean.

This year, Council officers WILL fine dog owners who do not carry means of collecting their dog's waste.

You clean up your own back yard, then why not treat public property with the same care?
